Data compression Lossless compression reduces bits by identifying and eliminating statistical redundancy. channel coding, for error detection and correction or line coding, the means for mapping data onto a signal. Typically, a device that performs data compression is referred to as an encoder, and one that performs the reversal of the process (decompression) as a decoder. Data compression algorithms present a space-time In information theory, data compression, source coding, or bit-rate reduction is the process of encoding information using fewer bits than the original representation. Any particular compression is either lossy or lossless. No information is lost in lossless compression. Lossy compression reduces bits by removing unnecessary or less important information 05c4ce1245

It makes more economical use of scarce radio spectrum space; it can transmit up to seven channels in the same bandwidth as a single analog channel, and provides many new features that analog television cannot. In the 2000s it was represented as the first significant evolution in television technology since color television in the 1950s. Modern digital television is transmitted in high-definition television (HDTV) with greater resolution than analog TV. It typically uses a widescreen aspect ratio (commonly 16:9) in contrast to the narrower format (4:3) of analog TV 05c4ce1245
