Indirect tests of memory WSC task is a verbal test of perceptual implicit memory. Types of indirect memory tests include the implicit association test, the lexical decision task, the word stem completion task, artificial grammar learning, word fragment completion, and the serial reaction time task. Performance on indirect tests may reflect contributions of implicit memory, the effects of priming, a preference to respond to previously experienced stimuli over novel stimuli. Participants are given tasks designed to elicit knowledge that was acquired incidentally or unconsciously and is evident when performance shows greater inclination towards items initially presented than new items. In this task a participant is presented with the first few letters of a word and asked to complete Indirect memory tests assess the retention of information without direct reference to the source of information dd2f0c7703

Practitioners use multiple techniques, such as the method of loci, the link system, the peg-word method, PAO (person, action, object), etc., to store information in long-term memory and to make it easier to recall this information in the future. One can make such connections visually, spatially, semantically or acoustically. dd2f0c7703

Graduate Record Examinations The test was established in 1936 by the Carnegie Foundation for the Advancement of Teaching. the GRE tested only for verbal and quantitative ability.

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The GRE is owned and administered by Educational Testing Service (ETS). For a number of years before October 2002, the GRE had a separate Analytical Ability section. The Graduate Record Examinations (GRE) is a standardized test that is part of the admissions process for many graduate schools in the United States, Canada, and a few other countries.

While SPCD shares similarities with other communication disorders, such as autism spectrum disorder (ASD), it is recognized as a distinct diagnostic category with its own set... According to ETS, the GRE aims to measure verbal reasoning, quantitative reasoning, analytical writing, and critical thinking skills that have been acquired over a long period of learning. The content of the GRE consists of certain specific data analysis or interpretation, arguments and reasoning, algebra, geometry, arithmetic, and vocabulary sections. The GRE General Test is offered as a computer-based exam administered at testing centers and institutions... The most recent version of the exam was introduced in April 2015 and takes approximately 7+1/2 hours to complete, including breaks. The test is scored in a range from 472 to 528. The MCAT is administered by the Association of American Medical Colleges (AAMC). **Turing test** In the test, a human evaluator judges a text transcript of a natural-language conversation between a human and a machine. The evaluator tries to identify the machine, and the machine passes if the evaluator cannot reliably tell them apart. The Turing test, originally called the imitation game by Alan Turing in 1949, is a test of a machine's ability to exhibit intelligent behaviour equivalent to that of a human. Since the Turing test is a test of indistinguishability in performance capacity, the verbal version generalizes naturally to all of human performance capacity, verbal as well as nonverbal (robotic). The results would not depend on the machine's ability to answer questions correctly, only on how closely its answers resembled those of a human.

**Social (pragmatic) communication disorder** Individuals with SPCD struggle to effectively indulge in social interactions, interpret social cues, and may struggle to use words appropriately in social contexts. This disorder can have a profound impact on an individual's ability to establish and maintain relationships, navigate social situations, and participate in academic settings. Social (pragmatic) communication disorder (SPCD), also known as semantic-pragmatic communication disorder, or pragmatic language impairment (PLI), is a neurodevelopmental disorder characterized by difficulties in the social use of verbal and nonverbal communication.

A basic task that demonstrates this effect occurs when there is an incongruent mismatch between the word for a color (e.g., blue, green, or red) and the font color it is printed in (e.g., the word red printed in a blue font). Typically, when a person is asked to name the font color for each word in a series of words, they take longer and are more prone to errors when words for colors are printed in incongruous font colors (e.g., it generally takes longer to say "blue" in response to the word red in a blue font, than in response to a neutral word of the same...).

**Elaborative encoding** In this system one attaches an additional piece of information to a memory task which makes it easier to recall. Coane used three different Elaborative encoding is a mnemonic system that uses some form of elaboration, such as an emotional cue, to assist in the retention of memories and knowledge. For instance, one may recognize a face easier if character traits are also imparted about the person at the same time. Coane tested a young group and an older group using 44 unique word pairs. The effect on the participants' ability to encode information was significant.

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
