Foodshed Estimates of all farm-to-table sales within a foodshed range from roughly \$550 million to \$2 billion. The term is used to describe a region of food flows, from the area where it is produced, to the place where it is consumed, including: the land it grows on, the route it travels, the markets it passes through, and the tables it ends up on. "Foodshed" is described as a "socio-geographic space: human activity embedded in the natural integument of a particular place. " A foodshed is analogous to a watershed in that foodsheds outline the flow of food feeding a particular population, whereas watersheds outline the flow of water draining to a particular location. Many local farms are family-run farms that are successful A foodshed is the geographic region that produces the food for a particular population.
