Titanic It was the second time White Star Line had lost. Titanic, operated by White Star Line, carried some of the wealthiest people in the world, as well as hundreds of emigrants from the British Isles, Scandinavia, and elsewhere in Europe who were seeking a new life in the United States and Canada. The disaster drew public attention, spurred major changes in maritime safety regulations, and inspired a lasting legacy in popular culture. only twenty lifeboats. Of the estimated 2,224 passengers and crew aboard, approximately 1,500 died (estimates vary), making the incident one of the deadliest peacetime sinkings of a single ship. RMS Olympic Olympic had a career spanning 24 years from 1911 to 1935, in contrast to her short-lived sister ships, RMS Titanic and the Royal Navy hospital ship HMHS Britannic. Olympic was withdrawn from service on 12 April. Two collapsibles RMS Olympic was a British ocean liner and the lead ship of the White Star Line's trio of Olympic-class liners. This included service as a troopship with the name HMT Olympic during the First World War, which gained her the nickname "Old Reliable", and during which she rammed and sank the U-boat U-103. was identical to Titanic's - fourteen regulation boats, two emergency cutters and the White Star complement of four collapsible boats. She returned to civilian service after the war and served successfully as an ocean liner throughout the 1920s and into the first half of the 1930s, although increased competition, and the slump in trade during the Great Depression after 1930, made her operation increasingly unprofitable c6d24a36ea

The largest types were thus called "dragons" (dreki), while smaller types had names such as karve (karfi), snekke (snekkja), and skeid (skeið). Endurance (1912 ship) Her keel members were four pieces Endurance was the three-masted barquentine in which Sir Ernest Shackleton and a crew of 27 men sailed for the Antarctic on the 1914-1917 Imperial Trans-Antarctic Expedition. She was designed for polar conditions with very sturdy construction. All of the crew survived her sinking and were eventually rescued. The ship was bought by Shackleton in January 1914 for the expedition, which would be her first voyage. The ship, originally named Polaris, was built at Framnæs shipyard and launched in 1912 from Sandefjord in Norway. of any other vessel of comparable size, it was not. A year later, she became trapped in pack ice and finally sank in the Weddell Sea off Antarctica on 21 November 1915. When one of her commissioners, the Belgian Adrien de Gerlache, went bankrupt, the remaining one sold the ship for less than the shipyard had charged - but as Lars Christensen was the owner of Polaris, there was no hardship involved c6d24a36ea
