Al-Muhajiroun The group was founded by Omar Bakri Muhammad, a Syrian who previously belonged to Hizb ut-Tahrir; he was not permitted to re-enter Britain after 2005. In its September 2002 conference "The Magnificent 19", it praised the September 11, 2001 attacks. The organisation has been linked to international terrorism, homophobia, and antisemitism. Majeerteen Sultanate It also entered into treaties with foreign powers and exerted strong centralized authority on domestic affairs. 'Boqortooyada Majerteen', Arabic: (سلطنة مجرتين), or Majerteen Kingdom also known as Majeerteenia and/or Migiurtinia, was a Somali kingdom centered in the Horn of Africa. arrived in Merca and formed an alliance with the Bimaal clan.
