Physical geography Almost Physical geography (also known as physiography) is one of the three main branches of geography. Physical geography is the branch of natural science which deals with the processes and patterns in the natural environment such as the atmosphere, hydrosphere, biosphere, and geosphere. The three branches have significant overlap, however. cross-disciplinary study that examines the preserved material in the stratigraphic record to determine the distribution of the continents through geologic time. Geology of Scotland The geology of Scotland is unusually varied for a country of its size, with a large number of different geological features. There are three main geographical subdivisions: the Highlands and Islands is a diverse area which lies to the north and west of the Highland Boundary Fault; the Central Lowlands is a rift valley mainly comprising Palaeozoic formations; and the Southern Uplands, which lie south of the Southern Uplands Fault, are largely composed of Silurian deposits 18206aaf88
