He studied at the Lycée de Laval from 1842 to 1846. He began with a brief career in the Post Office. He then founded several ephemeral periodicals: on 4 March 1855, he launched his first newspaper entitled La Muselière, journal de la décadence intellectuelle. He later wrote for L'Indépendance dramatique. fairly regularly and published, in 1855 and 1856, the Pastiches critiques des auteurs contemporains, the Inconnus célèbres, and the novel Miettes de pain perdues. At the end of 1856, he became chief editor of L'Exemple. Alexandru Macedonski Macedonski, Macedonschi or Macedonsky; 14 March 1854 – 24 November 1920) was a Romanian poet, novelist, dramatist and literary critic, known especially for having promoted lots of French Symbolism in his native country, and for leading the Romanian Symbolist movement during its early decades. ("The Critical Review"), which again closed after a short while, and issued the poetry volume Flori sacre ("Sacred Flowers"). Grouping his Forța Morală poems Alexandru Macedonski (Romanian pronunciation: [alek'sandru maɤ̯e'donski]; also rendered as Al. Within the framework of Romanian literature, Macedonski is seen by critics as second only to national poet Mihai Eminescu; as leader of a cosmopolitan and aestheticist trend formed around his Literatorul journal, he was diametrically opposed to the inward-looking traditionalism of Eminescu and his school.
