The pH scale ranges from 0 to 14. Substances with pH's near zero are strong acids, and substances with pH's near 14 are strong bases. Substances with pH's of 7 are neutral. Bleach is a strong base, and ammonia is a relatively weak base. Water is neutral. Since vinegar is the only acid listed, the pH of vinegar is the closest to a pH of 1. 370f73add5 ANSWER B: Electrons, protons, and neutrons are subatomic particles. Electrons have the smallest mass. Protons and neutrons, which are nearly equal in mass, are several orders of magnitude more massive than electrons.
