They are often used to do research and commercial work at great depths beyond the capacities of most submersibles and divers.

Wildrake diving accident Although the bell was eventually recovered by Wildrake, its two occupants, 32-year-old Richard Arthur Walker and 28-year-old Victor Francis "Skip" Guiel Jr. In early 1978, Brian Masterson, an English businessman The Wildrake diving accident was an incident in Scotland in August 1979 that killed two American commercial divers. , died of hypothermia. In April 1979 the riser was removed from the base by divers and taken to Bergen, Norway to be repaired. During a routine dive in the East Shetland Basin of the North Sea, the diving bell of the diving support vessel MS Wildrake became separated from its main lift wire at a depth of over 160 metres (520 ft). The accident resulted in extensive subsequent litigation and led to important safety changes in the diving industry
