Business process discovery Business process discovery (BPD) related to business process management and process mining is a set of techniques that manually or automatically construct Business process discovery (BPD) related to business process management and process mining is a set of techniques that manually or automatically construct a representation of an organisations' current business processes and their major process variations. Such a record qualifies for an event log and can be used to discover the underlying process. These techniques use data recorded in the existing organisational methods of work, documentations, and technology systems that run business processes within an organisation. The type of data required for process discovery is called an event log. Any record of data that contains the case id (a unique identifier that is helpful in grouping activities belonging to the same case), activity name (description of the activity taking place), and timestamp d98ed65ea6

Research to much more subjective non-quantitative, use different methods of collecting data, analyzing data, interpreting data for meanings, definitions, characteristics Research is creative and systematic work undertaken to increase the stock of knowledge. These activities are characterized by accounting and controlling for biases. A research project may be an expansion of past work in the field. It involves the collection, organization, and analysis of evidence to increase understanding of a topic, characterized by a particular attentiveness to controlling sources of bias and error. To test the validity of instruments, procedures, or experiments, research may replicate elements of prior projects or the project as a whole d98ed65ea6

Delphi has been widely used for business forecasting and has certain advantages over another structured forecasting approach, prediction markets. compared with actual sales d98ed65ea6

For example, In chemistry, the iodine value (IV; also iodine absorption value, iodine number or iodine index) is the mass of iodine in grams that is consumed by 100 grams of a chemical substance. In fatty acids, unsaturation occurs mainly as double bonds which are

very reactive towards halogens, the iodine in this case. It can be seen from the table that coconut oil is very saturated, which means it is good for making soap. Iodine numbers are often used to determine the degree of unsaturation in fats, oils and waxes d98ed65ea6
