It began in 1785 under the title The Daily Universal Register, adopting its modern name on 1 January 1788. It is considered a newspaper of record in the UK. In the same year, the paper's printer, James Lawson, died and passed the business onto his son The Times is a British daily national newspaper based in London. 000. The Times was the first newspaper to bear that name, inspiring numerous other papers around the world. Every state and territory has its own basic corporate code, while federal law creates minimum standards for trade in company shares and governance rights, found mostly in the Securities Act of 1933 and the Securities and Exchange Act of 1934, as amended by laws like the Sarbanes–Oxley Act of 2002 and the Dodd–Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act.
