Grade inflation equivalent Grade 1 CSE; a proportion being entered for neither paper. The percentage of the population obtaining at least a grade "C" or equivalent in maths, at Grade inflation (also known as grading leniency) is the general awarding of higher grades for the same quality of work over time, which devalues grades. For this to be grade inflation, it is necessary to demonstrate that the quality of work does not deserve the high grade. However, higher average grades in themselves do not prove grade inflation

Turing test The evaluator tries to identify the machine, and the machine passes if the evaluator cannot reliably tell them apart. In the test, a human evaluator judges a text transcript of a natural-language conversation between a human and a machine. can answer the question with which we are concerned in this paper. The results would not depend on the machine's ability to answer questions correctly, only on how closely its answers resembled those of a human. Since the Turing test is a test of indistinguishability in performance capacity, the verbal version generalizes naturally to all of human performance capacity, verbal as well as nonverbal (robotic). Mainstream AI researchers argue that trying to pass the Turing test is merely a distraction The Turing test, originally called the imitation game by Alan Turing in 1949, is a test of a machine's ability to exhibit intelligent behaviour equivalent to that of a human
