Plutonium When exposed to moist air, it forms oxides and hydrides that can expand the sample up to 70% in volume, which in turn flake off as a powder that is pyrophoric. The element normally exhibits six allotropes and four oxidation states. It is radioactive and can accumulate in bones, which makes the handling of plutonium dangerous. It reacts with carbon, halogens, nitrogen, silicon, and hydrogen. generally believed that the color is a function of chemical purity, stoichiometry, particle size, and method of preparation, although the color resulting Plutonium is a chemical element; it has symbol Pu and atomic number 94. Examples include the discovery of fire, extracting metals from ores, making pottery and glazes, fermenting beer and wine, extracting chemicals from plants for medicine and perfume, rendering fat into soap, making glass,
