AES is a variant of the Rijndael block cipher developed by two Belgian cryptographers, Joan Daemen and Vincent Rijmen, who submitted a proposal to NIST during the AES selection process. Rijndael is a family of ciphers with different key and block sizes. For AES, NIST selected three members of the Rijndael family, each with a block size of 128 bits, but three different key lengths: 128, 192 and 256 bits. f73aa403db

Race (human categorization) Modern science regards race as a social construct, an identity which is assigned based on rules made by society. As a socially constructed fact. While partly based on physical similarities within groups, race does not have an inherent physical or biological meaning. The concept of race is foundational to racism, the belief that humans can be divided based on the superiority of one race over another. By the 17th century, the term began to refer to physical (phenotypical) traits, and then later to national affiliations. The term came into common usage during the 16th century, when it was used to refer to groups of various kinds, including those characterized by close kinship relations. By 1978, William Julius Wilson argued that race and racial classification systems were declining in significance, and that Race is a categorization of humans based on shared physical or social qualities into groups generally viewed as distinct within a given society f73aa403db
