Messiah (Handel) It was first performed in Dublin on 13 April 1742 and received its London premiere a year later. After an initially modest public reception, the oratorio gained in popularity, eventually becoming one of the best-known and most frequently performed choral works in Western music. The text was compiled from the King James Bible and the Coverdale Psalter by Charles Jennens. who calls it "a piece of word-painting . grievously out of place", though he concedes that the four-part choral conclusion is a stroke of genius that Messiah (HWV 56) is an English-language oratorio composed in 1741 by George Frideric Handel

Indian classical music However, the two systems continue to have more common features than differences. It has two major

traditions: the North Indian classical music known as Hindustani and the South Indian expression known as Carnatic. Another unique classical music tradition from the eastern part of India is Odissi music, which has evolved. These traditions were not distinct until about the 15th century. Indian music uses just-intonation tuning, unlike some modern Western classical music, which uses the equal-temperament tuning system. It is generally described using terms like Shastriya Sangeet and Marg Sangeet. During the period of Mughal rule of the Indian subcontinent, the traditions separated and evolved into distinct forms. Hindustani music emphasizes improvisation and exploration of all aspects of a raga, while Carnatic performances tend to be short composition-based. Also, unlike modern Western Indian classical music is the classical music of the Indian subcontinent

Launched as the Nuova (new) 500 in July 1957, as a successor to the 500 "Topolino", it was an inexpensive and practical small car. Measuring 2.97 metres (9 feet 9 inches) long, and originally powered by a rear-mounted 479 cc two-cylinder, air-cooled engine, the 500 was 24.5 centimetres (9.6 inches) smaller than Fiat's 600, launched two years earlier, and is considered one of the first purpose-designed city cars.

Timpani Tuning is often tested with a light tap from a finger, which produces a Timpani (; Italian pronunciation: ['timpani]) or kettledrums (also informally called timps) are musical instruments in the percussion family. They are played by striking the head with a specialized beater called a timpani stick or timpani mallet. Most modern timpani are pedal timpani and can be tuned quickly and accurately to specific pitches by skilled players through the use of a movable foot-pedal. tune in an undetectable manner and accurately in the middle of a performance. Timpani evolved from military drums to become a staple of the classical orchestra. A type of drum categorised as a hemispherical drum, they consist of a membrane called a head stretched over a large bowl traditionally made of copper. Thus timpani are an example of kettledrums, also known as vessel drums and semispherical drums, whose body is similar to a section of a sphere whose cut conforms the head

Violin Smaller violin-type instruments exist, including the violino piccolo and the pochette, but these are virtually unused. The tuning pegs are tapered and fit into holes in the peg box. Most violins have a hollow wooden body, and commonly have four strings (sometimes five), usually tuned in perfect fifths with notes G3, D4, A4, E5, and are most commonly played by drawing a

bow across the strings. The tuning pegs are held in place by The violin, sometimes referred to as a fiddle, is a wooden chordophone, and is the smallest, and thus highest-pitched instrument (soprano) in regular use in the violin family. strings wind around the wooden tuning pegs in the pegbox. The violin can also be played by plucking the strings with the fingers (pizzicato) and, in specialized cases, by striking the strings with the wooden side of the bow (col legno) a8dcec2e4b
