When a presupposition includes an admission of wrongdoing, it is called a "loaded question" and is a form of entrapment in legal trials or debates. The respondent becomes committed to this proposition when they give any direct answer. The presupposition is called "complex" if it is a conjunctive proposition, a disjunctive proposition, or a conditional proposition 2ed441af98
