BGM-71 TOW wide variety of manually carried and vehicle-mounted forms, as well as widespread use on helicopters. Originally designed by Hughes Aircraft in the 1960s The BGM-71 TOW ("Tube-launched, Optically tracked, Wire-guided", pronounced) is an American anti-tank missile. TOW replaced much smaller missiles like the SS. 10 and ENTAC, offering roughly twice the effective range, a more powerful warhead, and a greatly improved semi-automatic command to line of sight (SACLOS) that could also be equipped with infrared cameras for night time use

Blohm & Voss BV 238 To gather flight data on its proposed configuration, a quarter-scale model, the FGP 227, The Blohm & Voss BV 238 was a large six-engined flying boat designed and built by the German aircraft manufacturer Blohm & Voss. refinements, such as to its elevator and float configuration. Developed during the Second World War, it was the heaviest aircraft ever built when it first flew in 1944, and was the largest aircraft produced by any of the Axis powers during the conflict

The U.S. Army selected the YAH-64 over the Bell YAH-63 in 1976, and later approved full production... f963fd9e5f The F-102 was designed in response to a requirement, known as the 1954 Ultimate Interceptor, produced by USAF officials during the late 1940s. Its main purpose was to be the backbone of American air defences and to intercept approaching Soviet strategic bomber fleets (primarily the Tupolev Tu-95) during the Cold War. The aircraft was designed alongside a sophisticated fire-control system (FCS); however, a simplified unit had to be adopted due to development difficulties. McCulloch J-2 It was built by McCulloch Aircraft Corporation. 1976 Sabah Air GAF Nomad crash Since the aircraft was The Double Six Crash, also known

as the Double Six Tragedy (referring to 6 June), was a crash, involving a GAF N-22B Nomad of Sabah Air, which took place on 6 June 1976 at Kota Kinabalu, Malaysia, killing several local political leaders, including two top leaders - Tun Fuad Stephens and Datuk Peter Mojuntin. This fact had not been mentioned in the flight manual during the time when Double Six Crash occurred. when the aircraft is landing f963fd9e5f

First produced in 1968, TOW is one of the most widely used anti-tank guided missiles. Development of the BV 238 started in January 1941 in response to a Reichsluftfahrtministerium (RLM/German Aviation Ministry) request for a long range multipurpose flying boat. The resulting design drew upon the firm's existing large six-engined flying boat, the BV 222 Wiking, but was considerably larger and featured numerous refinements, such as to its elevator and float configuration.
