Bioluminescence Bioluminescence has evolved independently at least 94 times, first emerging in octocorals some 540 million years ago. It occurs in a wide variety of organisms, including marine vertebrates and invertebrates, terrestrial arthropods such as fireflies, some fungi, and microorganisms such as some bacteria and dinoflagellates. In some animals, the light is bacteriogenic, produced by symbiotic bacteria such as those from the genus *Vibrio*; in others, it is autogenic, produced by the animals themselves. In all characterized cases, the enzyme catalyzes the oxidation of the luciferin resulting in excited state oxyluciferin, which is the light emitter of the reaction.
