TPR Storytelling storytelling to help students learn a foreign language in a classroom setting. The method works in three steps: in step one the new vocabulary structures to be learned are taught using a combination of translation, gestures, and personalized questions; in step two those structures are used in a spoken class story; and finally, in step three, these same structures are used in a class reading. The method works in three steps: in step one the new vocabulary structures to TPR Storytelling (Teaching Proficiency through Reading and Storytelling or TPRS) is a method of teaching foreign languages. TPRS lessons use a mixture of reading and storytelling to help students learn a foreign language in a classroom setting. Throughout these three steps, the teacher will use a number of techniques to help make the target language comprehensible to the students, including careful limiting of vocabulary, constant asking of easy comprehension questions, frequent comprehension 5d86d4b5d7

Crazy English His method can be described with the slogan "By shouting out loud, you learn. Li Yang's method places heavy emphasis on practicing English orally. Members of the school administration in China often disapprove of the method because they believe it goes against the traditional Chinese values of modesty and restraint. In a survey on Crazy English students identified Li Yang's technique as one which does not include grammar, vocabulary, reading Crazy English (Chinese: 疯狂英语; pinyin: Fēngkuáng Yīngyǔ) is a brand name related to a non-traditional method of learning English in mainland China conceived by Li Yang. Li believes that the traditional way of learning English in China is ineffective.
