Symptoms typically start anywhere between two days and three weeks after infection. It kills between 25% and 90% of those infected – about 50% on average. These are usually followed by vomiting, diarrhoea, rash and decreased liver and kidney function, at which point some people begin to bleed both internally and externally. cell determines when L switches from gene transcription to genome replication. Death is often due to shock from fluid loss, and typically occurs between 6 and 16 days after the first symptoms appear. The Insulin (, from Latin insula, 'island') is a peptide hormone produced by beta cells of the pancreatic islets encoded in humans by the insulin (INS) gene. Circulating insulin also affects the

synthesis of proteins in a wide variety of tissues. It is thus an anabolic hormone, promoting the. body cells) Increase of DNA replication and protein synthesis via control of amino acid uptake Modification of the activity of numerous enzymes. It is the main anabolic hormone of the body. Glucose production and secretion by the liver are strongly inhibited by high concentrations of insulin in the blood. In these tissues the absorbed glucose is converted into either glycogen, via glycogenesis, or fats (triglycerides), via lipogenesis; in the liver, glucose is converted into both

Cultured meat is produced using tissue engineering techniques pioneered in regenerative medicine. It has been noted for potential in lessening the impact of meat production on the environment and addressing issues around animal welfare, food security and human health
