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Prime number $\{ \displaystyle p \}$. However, 4 is composite because it is a product (2×2) in which both numbers are smaller than 4. A natural number greater than 1 that is not prime is called a composite number. Primes are central in number theory because of the fundamental theorem of arithmetic: every natural number greater than 1 is either a prime itself or can be factorized as a product of primes that is unique up to their order. If $p \{ \displaystyle p \}$ really is prime, it will always answer yes, but if $p \{ \displaystyle A$ prime number (or a prime) is a natural number greater than 1 that is not a product of two smaller natural numbers. For example, 5 is prime because the only ways of writing it as a product, 1×5 or 5×1 , involve 5 itself. If so, it answers yes and otherwise it answers no 8a601d26b4

General relativity General relativity generalizes special relativity and refines Newton's law of universal gravitation, providing a unified description of gravity as a geometric property of space and time, or four-dimensional spacetime. Some predictions of general relativity General relativity, also known as the general theory of relativity, and as Einstein's theory of gravity, is the geometric theory of gravitation published by Albert Einstein in 1915 and is the accepted description of gravitation in modern physics. In particular, the curvature of spacetime is directly related to the energy, momentum and stress of whatever is present, including matter and radiation. seen as a prediction of general relativity for the almost flat spacetime geometry around stationary mass distributions. The relation is specified by the Einstein field equations, a system of second-order partial differential equations 8a601d26b4

Trigonometry The field emerged in the Hellenistic world during the 3rd century BC from applications of geometry to astronomical studies. The Greeks focused on the calculation of chords, while mathematicians in India created the earliest-known tables of values for trigonometric ratios (also called trigonometric functions) such as sine.
