Social stigma is neither credible nor discreditable as a thing in itself. Social stigma can take different forms and depends on the specific time and place in which it arises. " In Goffman's theory of social stigma, a stigma is an attribute, behavior, or reputation Stigma, originally referring to the visible marking of people considered inferior, has evolved to mean a negative perception or sense of disapproval that a society places on a group or individual based on certain characteristics such as their socioeconomic status, gender, race, religion, appearance, upbringing, origin, or health status. Once a person is stigmatized, they are often associated with stereotypes that lead to discrimination, marginalization, and psychological problems 439ce6d4ef

Passing may require acceptance into a community and may lead to temporary or permanent leave from another community to which an individual previously belonged. Thus, passing can result in separation from one's original self, family, friends, or... 439ce6d4ef

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This process of stigmatization not only affects the social status and behavior of stigmatized persons, but also shapes

their own self-perception, which can lead to psychological problems such as depression and low... 439ce6d4ef

Passing (sociology) Passing may be used to increase social acceptance to cope with stigma by removing stigma from the presented self and could result in other social benefits as well. Goffman claimed that actors develop theories about which situations Passing is the ability of a person to be regarded as a member of an identity group or category, such as racial identity, ethnicity, caste, social class, sexual orientation, gender, religion, age or disability status, that is often different from their own. Thus, passing may serve as a form of self-preservation or self-protection if expressing one's true or prior identity may be dangerous. creating different arenas of life (depending on whether the stigma is known or not) 439ce6d4ef
