Temporomandibular joint dysfunction This mechanism is exacerbated by alcohol consumption, Temporomandibular joint dysfunction (TMD, TMJD) is an umbrella term covering pain and dysfunction of the muscles of mastication (the muscles that move the jaw) and the temporomandibular joints (the joints which connect the mandible to the skull). The most important feature is pain, followed by

restricted mandibular movement, and noises from the temporomandibular joints (TMJ) during jaw movement. Although TMD is not life-threatening, it can be detrimental to quality of life; this is because the symptoms can become chronic and difficult to manage. retrognathic posture that results in glossal blockage of the oropharynx as the tongue relaxes in sleep e1f771f7bc

Ekman transport Ekman transport occurs when ocean surface waters are influenced by the friction force acting on them via the wind. Winds are the main source of energy for ocean circulation, and Ekman transport is a component of wind-driven ocean current. The direction of transport is dependent on the hemisphere: in the northern hemisphere, transport veers clockwise from wind direction. $\{v\} + Be^{\{\lambda z\}}$ will suffice as a solution to the differential equations above. After substitution of these possible solutions in the same equations, $v \in \mathbb{R}^2$ Ekman transport is part of Ekman motion theory, first investigated in 1902 by Vagn Walfrid Ekman. As the wind blows it casts a friction force on the ocean surface that drags the upper 10-100m of the water column with it. However, due to the influence of the Coriolis effect, as the ocean water moves it is subject to a force at a 90° angle from the direction of motion causing

the water to move at an angle to the wind direction e1f771f7bc

The common name of "bullhorn" refers to the enlarged, hollowed-out, swollen thorns (technically called stipular spines) that occur in pairs at the base of leaves, and resemble the horns of a steer. In addition *Vachellia cornigera*, commonly known as bullhorn acacia (family Fabaceae), is a swollen-thorn tree and myrmecophyte native to Mexico and Central America e1f771f7bc

eliminate pain during or after surgery. When it is used on specific nerve pathways (local anesthetic nerve block), paralysis (loss of muscle function) also can be induced. Usually there is tissue swelling at the point of injection. A local anesthetic (LA) is a medication that causes absence of all sensation (including pain) in a specific body part without loss of consciousness, providing local anesthesia, as opposed to a general anesthetic, which eliminates all sensation in the entire body and causes unconsciousness.
