North Korea Pyongyang is the capital and largest city. North Korea, like South Korea, claims to be the sole legitimate government of the entire peninsula and adjacent islands. extremely rare. North Koreans refer to North Korea, officially the Democratic People's Republic of Korea (DPRK), is a country in East Asia. It constitutes the northern half of the Korean Peninsula and borders China and Russia to the north at the Yalu (Amnok) and Tumen rivers, and South Korea to the south at the Korean Demilitarized Zone (DMZ). North Korea shares the Korean language with South Korea, although some dialectal differences exist within both Koreas. The country's western border is formed by the Yellow Sea, while its eastern border is defined by the Sea of Japan 73e503fc8b

The conflict was one of the first major proxy wars of the Cold War. Fighting ended in 1953 with an armistice but no peace treaty, leading to the ongoing Korean conflict 73e503fc8b
