Health psychology Health psychologists take a biopsychosocial approach. The discipline is concerned with understanding how psychological, behavioral, and cultural factors contribute to physical health and illness. Health psychology is the study of psychological and behavioral processes in health, illness, and healthcare. Psychological factors can affect health directly. The discipline is concerned with understanding Health psychology is the study of psychological and behavioral processes in health, illness, and healthcare. For example, chronically occurring environmental stressors affecting the hypothalamic-pituitary-adrenal axis, cumulatively, can harm health. For example, certain behaviors can, over time, harm (smoking or consuming excessive amounts of alcohol) or enhance (engaging in exercise) health. In other words, health psychologists understand health to be the product not only of biological processes. Behavioral factors can also affect a person's health

A medical psychologist must obtain specific qualification in psychopharmacology to prescribe psychiatric medications and other pharmaceutical drugs. A trained medical psychologist or clinical psychopharmacologist with prescriptive

authority is a mid-level provider who prescribes psychotropic medication such as antidepressants for mental health disorders. However, a medical psychologist does not automatically equate with a psychologist having authority to prescribe medication. In fact, most medical psychologists do not prescribe medication and do not have authority to do so. Community psychology employs various perspectives within and outside psychology to address issues of communities, the relationships within them, and related people's attitudes and behaviour.

Developmental psychology Originally concerned with infants and children, the field has expanded to include adolescence, adult development, aging, and the entire lifespan. Within these three dimensions are a broad range of topics including motor skills, executive functions, moral understanding, language acquisition, social change, personality, emotional development, self-concept, and identity formation. Developmental psychologists aim to explain how thinking, feeling, and behaviors change throughout life. psychology is a representation of cross-cultural studies.
