List of chronometers on HMS Beagle These were first built in the 18th century and were used extensively by mariners in the 19th century and into the 20th century, even after the widespread use of radio for time signals – the time signal was used to set the chronometer, but the instrument was still necessary to display the time. For this system to work, a timepiece showing the time at the reference point must be carried to the measuring point.
