Some underwater work can be done by divers, but they are limited by depth and site conditions. When reasonably practicable, the bulk of the work is done out of the water, with underwater work restricted to installation, modification and repair, and inspection. And it is hazardous work, with expensive risk reduction and mitigation, and a limited range of suitable equipment. It can involve the use of a variety of building materials, mainly concrete and steel. Remotely operated underwater vehicles are an alternative for some classes of work, but are also limited and expensive. There is often, but not necessarily, a significant component of commercial diving involved 53ca900009

Software maintenance is often considered lower skilled and less rewarding than new development. As such, it is a common target for outsourcing or offshoring. Usually, the team developing the software is different from those who will be maintaining it. The developers lack an incentive to write the code to be easily maintained. Software is often delivered incomplete and almost always contains some bugs that the maintenance team must fix. Software maintenance often initially includes the development of new functionality, but as the product nears the end of its lifespan, maintenance is reduced to the bare minimum and then cut off entirely before the product is withdrawn. 53ca900009
