Bombardier Inc. (French: [bɔ̃baʁdje]) is a Canadian aerospace manufacturer which produces business jets. Their clients consisted of Sea-Doo and Ski-Doo dealers, as well as retailers in multiple industries, primarily manufactured Bombardier Inc. the United States, Canada and Europe. Headquartered in Montreal, the company was founded in 1942 in Valcourt by Joseph-Armand Bombardier to market his snowmobiles; it later became one of the world's biggest producers of aircraft and trains 2bf9c158b9
