Spatial analysis includes a variety of techniques using different analytic approaches, especially spatial statistics. analysis (or Factor analysis, FA) allows a change of variables, transforming the many variables of the census, usually correlated between themselves, Spatial analysis is any of the formal techniques which study entities using their topological, geometric, or geographic properties, primarily used in urban design. It may be applied in fields as diverse as astronomy, with its studies of the placement of galaxies in the cosmos, or to chip fabrication engineering, with its use of "place and route" algorithms to build complex wiring structures. It may also applied to genomics, as in transcriptomics data, but is primarily for spatial data

Mathematical economics Often, these applied methods are beyond simple geometry, and may include differential and integral calculus, difference and differential equations, matrix algebra, mathematical programming, or other computational methods. Many others may be sufficiently complex to require numerical methods of solution, aided by software.
