Health technology assessment The purpose of HTA is to inform "decision-making in order to promote an equitable, efficient, and high-quality health system". It has other definitions including "a method of evidence synthesis that considers evidence regarding clinical effectiveness, safety, cost-effectiveness and, when broadly applied, includes social, ethical, and legal aspects of the use of health technologies. coverage decisions by insurers and national health systems, in which case HTAs should include benefit-harm assessment and economic evaluation. " And "a Health technology assessment (HTA) is a multidisciplinary process that uses systematic and explicit methods to evaluate the properties and effects of a health technology. The precise balance of these inputs depends on. Health technology is conceived as any intervention (test, device, medicine, vaccine, procedure, program) at any point in its lifecycle (pre-market, regulatory approval, post-market, disinvestment) d6bf813cc8

Decision theory It differs from the cognitive and behavioral sciences in that it is mainly prescriptive and concerned with identifying optimal decisions for a rational agent, rather than describing how people actually make decisions. been increasing interest in "behavioral decision theory";, contributing to a re-evaluation of what useful decision-making requires. Despite this, the field is important to the study of real human behavior by social scientists, as it lays the foundations to mathematically model and analyze individuals in fields such as sociology, economics, criminology, cognitive science, moral philosophy and political science. The area of choice under Decision theory or the theory of rational choice is a branch of probability, economics, and analytic philosophy that uses expected utility and probability to model how individuals would behave rationally under uncertainty d6bf813cc8

ADM may involve large-scale data from a range of sources, such as databases, text, social media, sensors, images or speech, that is processed using various technologies including computer software, algorithms, machine learning, natural language processing, artificial intelligence, augmented intelligence and robotics d6bf813cc8

Occupational health psychology OHP addresses a number of major topic areas including the impact of occupational stressors on physical and mental health, the impact of involuntary unemployment on physical and mental health, work-family balance, workplace violence and other forms of mistreatment, psychosocial workplace factors that affect accident risk and safety, and interventions designed to improve and/or protect worker health. The model suggests not only that these two job factors are related to poorer health but that high levels of decision latitude on the Occupational health psychology (OHP) is an interdisciplinary area of psychology that is concerned with the health and safety of workers. Although OHP emerged from two distinct disciplines within applied psychology, namely, health psychology and industrial and organizational (I-O) psychology, historical evidence suggests that the origins of OHP lie in occupational health/occupational medicine. It could be either rational or irrational. Every decision-making process produces a final choice, which may or may not prompt action. The decision-making process is a reasoning process based on assumptions of values, preferences and beliefs of the decision-maker d6bf813cc8
