Permeable paving Permeable paving systems have shown effective in reducing suspended solids, Biochemical Permeable paving surfaces are made of either a porous material that enables stormwater to flow through it or nonporous blocks spaced so that water can flow between the gaps. Permeable pavement surfaces may be composed of; pervious concrete, porous asphalt, paving stones, or interlocking pavers. Permeable paving can also include a variety of surfacing techniques for roads, parking lots, and pedestrian walkways. Unlike traditional impervious paving materials such as concrete and asphalt, permeable paving systems allow stormwater to percolate and infiltrate through the pavement and into the aggregate layers and/or soil below. In addition to reducing surface runoff, permeable paving systems can trap suspended solids, thereby filtering pollutants from stormwater. released back into municipal stormwater management systems after a storm b562abc004

Lockout-tagout It requires that hazardous energy sources be "isolated and rendered inoperative" before work Lock out, tag out or lockout-tagout (LOTO) is a safety procedure used to ensure that dangerous equipment is properly shut off and not able to be started up again prior to the completion of

maintenance or repair work. The worker then holds the key for the lock, ensuring that only that worker can remove the lock and start the equipment. It requires that hazardous energy sources be "isolated and rendered inoperative" before work is started on the equipment in question. This prevents accidental startup of equipment while it is in a hazardous state or while a worker is in direct contact with it. again prior to the completion of maintenance or repair work. The isolated power sources are then locked and a tag is placed on the lock identifying the worker and reason the LOTO is placed on it b562abc004
