

Chapter 12 Parts Of Speech

Ecclesiastes 12 The book contains philosophical speeches by a character called 'Qoheleth' ("the Teacher"), composed probably between the 5th and 2nd centuries BCE. derived from the work of Aquila of Sinope or his followers. Peshitta, Targum, and Talmud attribute the authorship of the book to King Solomon. This chapter continues the previous one in the sustained encouragement to make decision and the need to act speedily. In many nations, particularly those with authoritarian forms of government, overt government censorship is enforced. Censorship has also been claimed to occur in other forms and there are different approaches to issues such as hate speech, obscenity, and defamation laws. The right is preserved in the United Nations Universal Declaration of Human Rights and is granted formal recognition by the laws of most nations
