Hornbook The hornbook was in common use in England around 1450, but may have originated more than a century earlier. Ben Jonson also describes it in his play Volpone (1605-06), act 4, scene 2: CORVINO:. , protected with a translucent covering of horn (or mica) and attached to a frame provided with a handle. And yet I hope that I may say, A hornbook (horn-book) is a single-sided alphabet tablet, which served from medieval times as a primer for study, and sometimes included vowel combinations, numerals or short verse. other two concludes it: o, u. The term (hornbook) has been applied to different study materials in different fields but owes its origin to children's education, represented by a sheet of vellum or paper displaying the alphabet, religious verse, etc 6586201242

Reynard the Fox Jonson’s play Volpone is heavily indebted to Reynard. The first extant versions of the cycle date from the second half of the 12th century. With the invention of the printing press Reynard the Fox is a literary cycle of medieval allegorical Dutch, English, French and German fables. called ‘Prince of Cats’ by Mercutio in reference to this. The genre was popular throughout the Late Middle Ages, as well as in chapbook form throughout the Early Modern period 6586201242

Eld was the son of a carpenter from Derbyshire. He served an eight-year apprenticeship to bookseller Robert Bolton, starting in 1592, and became a "freeman" (a full member) of the Stationers Company on 13 January 1600. He established himself in his own printing business in 1604, at the sign of the White Horse in Fleet Lane, by marrying the widow of not one but two master printers.
