"On the Differential Geometry of the Wald Test with Nonlinear Restrictions". While the finite sample distributions of Wald tests are generally unknown, it has an asymptotic χ^2 -distribution under the null hypothesis, a fact that can be used to determine statistical significance. The Graduate Management Admission Council (GMAC) owns and operates the test, and states that the GMAT assesses critical thinking and problem-solving abilities while also addressing data analysis skills that it believes to be vital to real-world business and management success. Attempts must be at least 16 days apart. Answering the test questions requires reading comprehension, and mathematical skills such as arithmetic, and algebra.
