The main approaches to gifted education are enrichment and acceleration. An enrichment program teaches additional, deeper material, but keeps the student progressing through the curriculum at the same rate as other students. An acceleration program advances the student through the standard curriculum faster than normal. This is normally done by having the students skip one to two grades.
