The RS-4-TCs were powered by a supercharged twelve-cylinder diesel engine rated at 400 horsepower (298 kW), and rode on a pair of two-axle trucks in a B-B wheel

arrangement. 74 of these models were built mainly for the Army while a few of them went to the Air Force 99522fc4cf

USCGC Balsam bow thruster was installed, powered by a Caterpillar 3406 TAT engine. She operated in the Pacific Ocean during World War II, then saw service along the United States West Coast, Hawaii, and Alaska. After her decommissioning in 1975, she was repurposed as a crab catcher-processor and is active in Alaskan fisheries as F/V Baranof.
