The principle is named after the Swiss mathematician and physicist Daniel Bernoulli, who published it in his book *Hydrodynamica* in 1738. Although Bernoulli deduced that pressure decreases when the flow speed increases, it was Leonhard Euler in 1752 who derived Bernoulli's equation in its usual form. For example, for a fluid flowing horizontally Bernoulli's principle states that an increase in the speed occurs simultaneously with a decrease in pressure 797a9c9af3

Machine The term is commonly applied to artificial devices, such as those employing engines or motors, but also to natural biological macromolecules, such as molecular machines. A hydraulic system uses an incompressible liquid as its fluid, rather than a compressible gas.
