Base erosion and profit shifting For the government, the tax base is a company's income or profit. Tax is levied as a percentage on this income or profit. As a result, tax revenues are reduced and the country is disadvantaged. There are many definitions of a business cycle. The simplest defines recessions as two consecutive quarters of negative GDP growth. More satisfactory classifications are provided by, first including more economic indicators and second by looking for more data patterns than the two quarter definition. In the United States, the National Bureau of Economic Research oversees a Business Cycle Dating Committee that defines a recession as "a significant decline in economic activity spread across the market, lasting... 7d78806ca8
