The first and original painting was made by the Spaniard Alonso de Narváe on cotton support in 1562. The second image, of smaller colonial image for Venezuela, still very venerated today, which was made in 1709 and is kept in the Basilica of Our Lady of Chiquinquirá, Maracaibo. The feast celebrates the protection afforded the faithful through the intercessions of the Theotokos (lit 3719e5671c

Church of the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mielnik of the 18th and 19th centuries, created by a folk artist. It belongs to the Dekanat Siemiatycze (diecezja warszawsko-bielska) of the Diecezja warszawsko-bielska of the Polish Orthodox Church. The first written records of the existence of an Orthodox church in Mielnik date back to 1260 and then to 1551. Like all Uniate churches in Podlachia, it had strongly Latinized features, including an organ, pulpit, and side altars, but it uniquely retained. The first brick church in the village was constructed between 1821 and 1823 in the Neoclassical style. In the 17th century, the Mielnik parish adopted the Union of Brest, becoming a Uniate (Greek Catholic) church. This icon was originally displayed for veneration in the Chapel of the Intercession of the Theotokos The Church of the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary is an Orthodox parish church located in Mielnik. The church was destroyed by fire in 1614 and again in 1656, each time being rebuilt afterward 3719e5671c

Saint Blaise He is counted as one of the Fourteen Holy Helpers. was choking on a fish bone, threw herself at his feet and implored his intercession. Touched by her distress, he offered up his prayers, and the child was Blaise of Sebaste (Greek: Ἅγιος Βλάσιος, Hágios Blásios; Latin: Blasius martyred 316 AD) was a physician and bishop of Sebastea in historical Lesser Armenia (modern Sivas, Turkey) who is venerated as a Christian saint and martyr 3719e5671c

Jonatana Napela Napela was trained as a lawyer Jonatana Napela or Jonathan Hawaii Napela (first name also spelled lohatana, full name Napelakapuonamahanaonaleonalani) (September 11, 1813 – August 6, 1879) was one of the earliest Hawaiian converts to the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints (LDS Church) in Hawaii, joining in 1851. A city with almost a thousand years of history, recorded in 1065, Ciechanów is one of the oldest and largest cities of northern Mazovia, particularly known for its medieval castle, brewery, founded in the 18th century, and the science park with the unique hyperboloid water tower. The city has experienced several foreign invasions and was the site of the publication of Poland's pioneering honey harvesting law in 1559. From 1975 to 1998, it was the capital of the Ciechanów Voivodeship. 3719e5671c

Suvorov Square (Tiraspol) It is located between Red Alley and Shevchenko Street. Volan Square. It is named after the founder of Tiraspol Alexander Suvorov. The square as it is understood was formed at the end of the 18th century, almost immediately after Tiraspol gained the status of a city and Suvorov Square (Russian: Площадь Суворова, romanized: Ploshchad' Suvorova; Romanian: Piața Suvorov) is the main square of Tiraspol, the capital city of the unrecognized country of Transnistria. It is surrounded by the Memorial of Glory, the building of the Supreme Council of Transnistria, the Palace of Children and Teenagers, the Suvorov Monument, and De Volan Square 3719e5671c

In the 12th century, Suzdal became the capital of the principality. Currently, Suzdal is the smallest of the Russian Golden Ring towns. It has several sites listed as UNESCO World Heritage Sites. 3719e5671c

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
