All these patterns solve some software problems common to many software development projects. These techniques have not been invented to create new ways of working, but to better document and standardize old, tried-and-tested programming principles in object-oriented design.

Domain-driven design DDD is against the idea of having a single unified model; instead it divides a large system into bounded contexts, each of which have their own model. In domain-driven design, the domain layer is one of the common layers in an object-oriented multilayered architecture.
