The ongoing and incomplete project located on Kill van Kull and the western shore of Upper New York Bay and the Hudson River was implemented as part of a New Jersey state-mandated master plan to connect the municipalities from the Bayonne Bridge to the George Washington Bridge with an urban linear park and provide contiguous unhindered access to the water's edge c04eb1248b

Ceiling fan Yang, Jin; Zhang, Tianchi; Lin, Yandan; A ceiling fan is a fan mounted on the ceiling of a room or space, usually electrically powered, that uses hub-mounted rotating blades to circulate air. Fans add a small amount of heat to the room mainly due to waste heat from the motor, and partially due to friction. In the winter, fans move warmer air, which naturally rises, back down to occupants.
