These 75-foot-long (23 m) ships are buried side by side and have wooden Several ancient Egyptian solar ships and boat pits were found in many ancient Egyptian sites. The history and function of the ships are not precisely known. Because of these ships' association with the sun, they are often found in an east. Similarly, another explanation behind these boats is that they were built for past kings to carry them to the afterlife. to the early first dynasty (2950–2775 BC), possibly associated with Hor-Aha. This is a common theme in the Pyramid Texts, and these buried boats might be a real-life equivalent of solar barges. The most famous is the Khufu ship, which is now preserved in the Grand Egyptian Museum.
