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Grade inflation Prospective employers must rely on indicators other than grades, such as internships and work Grade inflation (also known as grading leniency) is the general awarding of higher grades for the same quality of work over time, which devalues grades. compare students who took their exams at different times. For this to be grade inflation, it is necessary to demonstrate that the quality of work does not deserve the high grade. However, higher average grades in themselves do not prove grade inflation
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In general usage, the school-leaving exams, which are government-administered, are known as the "matric exams"; by extension, students in the final year of high school (grade 12) are known as "matriculants" or, more commonly, "matrics". Once the Matric year has been passed, students are said to have "matriculated".
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Central Board of Secondary Education For the Class 10 and Class 12 exams, CBSE (along with the marks obtained) includes the positional grade obtained by the student, which The Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) is a national-level board of education in India for public and private schools, controlled and managed by the Government of India. Established in 1929 by a resolution of the government, the Board was an experiment towards inter-state integration and cooperation in the sphere of secondary education. All schools affiliated with CBSE follow the NCERT curriculum, especially those in classes 9 to 12. The current Chairperson of CBSE is Rahul Singh, IAS. There are more than 27,000 schools in India and 240 schools in 28 foreign countries affiliated with the CBSE. the next year
