The Board ceased operations in 1963.

Playwrights' Advisory Board Members of the board included names such as Dymphna Cusack and Sumner Locke Elliott. Its functions included negotiating productions with theatres, acting as an intermediary in the nomination and collection of royalties, advising theatres and playwrights on scripts, and holding script competitions.
