Medicare (United States) Medicare has undergone several major changes since 1965; provisions have expanded to include benefits for speech, physical, and chiropractic therapy in Medicare is a federal health insurance program in the United States for people age 65 or older and younger people with

disabilities, including those with end stage renal disease and amyotrophic lateral sclerosis (ALS or Lou Gehrig's disease). It started in 1965 under the Social Security Administration and is now administered by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) db2c68ceb5

Veterans Health Administration noticeable improvements, compared with the same key indicators used for the Medicare fee for service system, as soon as two years after the reorganization. It is the largest division in the department, and second largest in the entire federal government, employing over 350,000 employees. The Veterans Health Administration (VHA) is the component of the United States Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) led by the under secretary of veterans affairs for health that implements the healthcare program of the VA through a nationalized healthcare service in the United States, providing healthcare and healthcare-adjacent services to veterans through the administration and operation of 146 VA Medical Centers (VAMC) with integrated outpatient clinics, 772 Community Based Outpatient Clinics (CBOC), and 134 VA Community Living Centers (VA Nursing Home) Programs. Medicare is divided into four parts: A, B, C and D. Part A covers hospital, skilled nursing, and hospice services. Part B covers outpatient services. Part D covers self-administered prescription drugs. Part C is an alternative that allows patients to choose private plans with different benefit structures that provide the same services as Parts A and B, usually with additional benefits. db2c68ceb5

Nursing homes also offer other services, A nursing home is a facility for the residential care of older people, senior citizens, or disabled people. Nursing homes are used by people who do not need to be in a hospital, but require care that is hard to provide in a home setting. Services may include physical therapy, occupational therapy, or speech-language therapy. illness, or injury. Most nursing homes have nursing aides and skilled nurses on hand 24 hours a day. Nursing homes may also be referred to as care homes, skilled nursing facilities (SNF), rest homes, long-term care facilities or more informally old people's homes db2c68ceb5
