It typically involves qualitative feedback (rather than scores) for both student and teacher that focuses on the details of content and performance. The goal of a formative assessment is to monitor student learning to provide ongoing feedback that can help students identify their strengths and weaknesses and target areas that need work. Metacognition high-risk option if they answered correctly in the working memory task but select the low-risk option if they were failed in the memory task. There are generally two components of metacognition: (1) cognitive conceptions and (2) a cognitive regulation system. Metamemory, defined as knowing about memory and mnemonic strategies, is an important aspect of metacognition. The term comes from the root word meta, meaning "beyond", or "on top of". Research has shown that both components of metacognition play key roles in metaconceptual knowledge and learning. Metacognition can take many forms, such as reflecting on one's ways of thinking, and knowing when and how oneself and others use particular strategies for problem-solving.
