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Body farm Bones entitled “The Feet on the Beach”, medical anthropologist Dr. The aim was to gain a better understanding of the decomposition process, permitting the development of techniques for extracting information such as the timing and circumstances of death from human remains. By placing the bodies outside to face the elements, researchers are able to get a better understanding of the decomposition process. Body farm research is of particular interest in forensic anthropology and related disciplines, and has applications in the fields of law enforcement and forensic science. Temperance Brennan and her partner FBI Special Agent Seeley Booth visit a body farm at A body farm is a research facility where decomposition of humans and animals can be studied in a variety of settings. Following the outdoor research, skeletal remains are cleaned and curated. Numerous purposes exist for these research facilities, yet their main purpose is to study and form an understanding of the decompositional changes that occur with the human body.
