Eustrongylidosis Eustrongylidosis is named after the causative agent Eustrongylides, and typically occurs in eutrophicated waters where concentrations of nutrients and minerals are high enough to provide ideal conditions for the parasite to thrive and persist.

Parasites are known to be indicators of environmental health and stability, so should be studied further to better understand the parasite's lifecycle. Eustrongylidosis is a parasitic disease that mainly affects wading birds worldwide; however, the parasite's complex, indirect lifecycle involves other species, such as aquatic worms and fish. Moreover, this disease is zoonotic, which means the parasite can transmit disease from animals to humans. Because eutrophication has become a common issue due to agricultural runoff and urban development, cases of eustrongylidosis are becoming prevalent and hard to control. Ichthyophthirius multifiliis It is visible as a white spot on the surface of the fish but, due to its internal microhabitat, it is a true endoparasite and not an ectoparasite. Only one species is found in the genus which also gave name to the family. The parasite can infect most freshwater fish species and, in contrast to many other

parasites, shows low host specificity. It *Ichthyophthirius multifiliis*, often termed "Ich", is a parasitic ciliate. The name literally translates as "the fish louse with many children". 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Formication The word is derived from *formica*, the Latin word for ant. small insects or similar parasites, despite repeated reassurances from physicians, pest control experts, and entomologists. It is one specific form of a set of sensations known as paresthesias, which also include the more common prickling, tingling sensation known as pins and needles. Formication is a well-documented symptom which has numerous possible causes. meleagridis is a species of parasitic protozoan that infects a wide range of birds including chickens, turkeys, peafowl, quail and pheasants, causing infectious enterohepatitis, or histomoniasis (blackhead diseases). It is transmitted by another cecal parasite, the nematode *Heterakis gallinarum*. only for a few hours in the external environment. H. Fish diseases and parasites If pathogens breach these defences, fish can develop inflammatory responses that increase the flow of blood to infected areas and deliver white blood cells that attempt to destroy the pathogens. Other external parasites found on gills are leeches and, in seawater, larvae of gnathiid isopods. Non-specific defences include skin and scales, as well as the mucus layer secreted by the epidermis that traps microorganisms and inhibits their growth. Isopod fish parasites are mostly external and feed Like humans and other animals, fish suffer from diseases and parasites.

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Cestoda Species of the other subclass, Cestodaria, are mainly fish-infecting parasites. Some cestodes are host-specific, while others are parasites of a wide Cestoda is a class of parasitic worms in the flatworm phylum (Platyhelminthes). Their bodies consist of many similar units known as proglottids—essentially packages of eggs which are regularly shed into the environment to infect other organisms. a crustacean and then one or more freshwater fish; its definitive host is a mammal. 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Due to the artificially limited volume of water and high concentration of fish in most aquarium tanks, communicable diseases often affect most or all fish in a tank. An improper nitrogen cycle, inappropriate aquarium plants and potentially harmful freshwater invertebrates can directly harm or add to the stresses on ornamental fish in a tank.
