Franklin Hall (minister) Franklin Hall (October 4, 1907 - January 13, 1993) was an American Christian minister and faith healer. He was a prominent minister in the Healing Revival during the 1940s and 1950s, a well known author in the Pentecostal movement, and an important leader in the Latter Rain movement. established the Fasting and Prayer Daily Revival Center. Hall did missionary work in Africa and was particularly active. His teachings on fasting were particularly influential in the Latter Rain movement. Hall founded Miracle Temple in San Diego in 1946, where he established the Fasting and Prayer Daily Revival Center. In 1956 Franklin moved his headquarters to Phoenix, Arizona, where he established the International Healing Cathedral and the Hall Deliverance Foundation. Hall, he was the oldest of six children.
