Internationally, Isaac was most well known for his tireless work after the Second World War in the field of Jewish-Christian relations, starting with his book *Jésus et Israël*, which was written during the war and made him a protagonist in the Seelisberg Conference of 1947, culminating in his decisive key role in the origin of the groundbreaking declaration *Nostra Aetate* during the Second Vatican Council. Hannah Arendt Her dissertation was entitled *Love and Saint* Hannah Arendt (born Johanna Arendt; 14 October 1906 – 4 December 1975) was a German and American historian and philosopher. while she was his student. John O'Neill (sociologist) Philosophy and Phenomenological John O'Neill (July 17, 1933 - September 7, 2022) was an English sociologist, phenomenologist, and social theorist known for his writings on critical social theory, philosophy, political economy, literary theory, psychoanalysis, and mass culture. O'Neill was Distinguished Professor of Sociology at York University (Emeritus), where he also co-founded the Programme in Social and Political Thought in 1972. O'Neill was the author, editor, and translator of over 30 books and hundreds of articles, many of which have been translated into French, German, Japanese, and Mandarin. O'Neill's work focuses on the notion of corporeal knowledge and embodiment as mediated by familial relationships and social welfare

Her works cover a broad range of topics, but she is best known for those dealing with the nature of wealth, power, fame, and evil, as well as politics, direct democracy, authority, tradition, and totalitarianism. She is also remembered for the controversy surrounding the trial of Adolf Eichmann, for her attempt to explain how ordinary people become actors in totalitarian systems, which was considered by some an apologia, and for the phrase "the banality of evil." Her name appears in the names of journals, schools, scholarly prizes, humanitarian prizes, think-tanks, and streets; appears on... During his career, Derrida published over 40 books, together with hundreds of essays and public presentations. He has had a significant influence on the humanities and social sciences, including philosophy, literature, law, anthropology, historiography...

Jean Baudrillard His work is frequently associated with postmodernism and specifically post-structuralism. He is best known for his analyses of media, contemporary culture, and technological communication, as well as his formulation of concepts such as hyperreality. (at the Lycée at Reims), he became aware of 'pataphysics, a parody of the philosophy of science, via philosophy professor Emmanuel Peillet (1914-1973), Jean Baudrillard (UK: , US: ; French: [ʒɑ̃ bodʁijɑʁ]; 27 July 1929 – 6 March 2007) was a French sociologist and philosopher with an interest in cultural studies. Baudrillard wrote about diverse subjects, including consumerism, critique of economy, social history, aesthetics, Western foreign policy, and popular culture. Nevertheless, Baudrillard had also opposed post-structuralism, and had distanced himself. Among his most well-known works are *Seduction* (1978), *Simulacra and Simulation* (1981), *America* (1986), and *The Gulf War Did Not Take Place* (1991)

Martin Heidegger 432. Žižek is the most famous associate of the Ljubljana School of Psychoanalysis, a group of Slovenian academics working on German... In April 1933, Heidegger was elected as rector at the University of Freiburg and has been widely criticized for his membership and support for the Nazi Party during his tenure. After World War II he was dismissed from Freiburg and banned from teaching

after denazification hearings at Freiburg. There has been controversy about the relationship between his philosophy and Nazism. 6b575b8fcd Žižek is the international director of the Birkbeck Institute for the Humanities at the University of London, Global Distinguished Professor of German at New York University, professor of philosophy and psychoanalysis at the European Graduate School and senior researcher at the Institute for Sociology and Philosophy at the University of Ljubljana.
